

A list of the Covid-19 virus measures being taken are listed below.

COVID-19 VIRUS

We have re-opened our “Swap Meet” by establishing a Covid-19 program that we will be following with guidelines for staff, spectators, food vendors and car part vendors.

We will first ask that any person feeling under the weather or experiencing any possible contagious medical problems must not attend the event for the safety of their fellow citizen. Signs will be placed at our entry gates requiring 6 feet minimum social distancing, staying within your own party not to exceed Ten family members.

At the entry gates attendees will be greeted by our entry gate staff members wearing “Masks” and gloves. If attendees have exact change it will limit potential spread of contamination. At our walk gate hand sanitizer dispensing will be available.

If restrooms are needed during attendees visit the doors will be secured open, hand sanitizers made available and periodic surface sanitizing will be done throughout the event. Flat style hand towels are there for attendees’ convenience and protection. When entering attendees can pull-out your own one or two towels to open the stall doors, flush the urinal or toilet handle, squirt the hand sanitizer and dispose of the paper towel in the trash receptacle at the entry/exit doorway.

Masks are preferred during attendees stroll up and down many lanes of vendors but not mandatory.

When parking, spectators will be informed to please practice social distancing of 6 Feet minimum when exiting and entering their vehicle.

We of the Sumter Swap Meet are trying to help in any way possible during this unexpected “PANDEMIC.”

SANITATION MEASURES

STAFF

1. Staff must be in "Good Health" when working the events, whether they are volunteers or hourly staff members. If ill they should make every attempt to notify office staff of their ailment at the earliest possible time.
2. Upon arrival they will be given sanitized radio's, hand sanitizers, masks or allowed to use their own masks before going to their assigned jobs. Company masks will be discarded in a covered trash receptacle at the end of each event.

VENDORS

Vendors will be asked to wear masks preferably Covid-19 resistant, during normal event hours 8am-3pm or while packing product if spectators are within 6 Feet of their person.

FOOD VENDORS

1. Must have a state and/or county Health Dept. operational License.
2. Must have patrons practice 6 foot min. social distancing while ordering and consuming food.
3. Operators must wear C-19 approved face masks and gloves.

SPECTATORS

1. Spectators will see signs at show entry gates and throughout the event requesting that social distancing of at least 6 Feet be observed while walking the event.
2. Follow restroom good hygiene practices as noted on placards posted in all facility restrooms and portlets.
